1. <u>Scholarship</u>

(1) Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO) loans

JASSO is the largest source of academic loans in Japan. About 20% of Tokyo Institute of Technology students take advantage of the program, which is open to students who are Japanese nationals and some foreign students, such as long-term residents. Class 1 loans are interest-free, while Class 2 loans charge interest.

(2) Scholarships for international students

Non-Japanese students attending Tokyo Institute of Technology at their own expense are eligible to apply for two types of scholarships from private scholarship foundations. The procedure for applying for each of these private scholarships is different. In one case, the student can apply directly for the scholarship without any recommendation from the University. In the second case, a recommendation from the University is required.

2. Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS) Research Fellowship for Young Scientists

(1) Doctoral Course Students (DC)

- Monthly stipend: 200,000 yen / research grant (Grant-in-Aid for JSPS Fellows): Up to 1.5 million yen / year
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ Part-time job and scholarship cannot be paid together.
